CIRCLE OF LIFE

Changing roles. It's never been easy. And while it's become commonplace in the world in which we live today – from 50 Shades of Grey to Caitlyn Jenner – it's always an uncomfortable, uphill journey.

The same holds true in the world of college football whenever teams are asked to assume a new role from one game to the next. Particularly so when they are suddenly favored after having just pulled an upset as an underdog.

In fact, college football conference road favorites off a SU conference home underdog win own a meager 77-104-4 ATS losing mark since 1980.

Better yet, our well-oiled machine tells us the best role in which to fade these situation role changers is to...

PLAY AGAINST any college football conference road favorite off a SU home underdog win versus an opponent off a SU underdog win.

That's because these uncomfortable road favorites are a **2-21 ATS** losing proposition in this hard-to-handle role change since 1990.

Last year witnessed two such plays when Utah State journeyed out as

4-point road chalk at San Diego State after upsetting Boise State, 52-26, as 7.5-point home pups the previous week. The Aggies promptly fell on their face in a 48-14 loss against the Aztecs. San Diego State then went out as 3-point road faves the following week at Colorado State, yet somehow managed to win and cover against the Rams in a rare win.

FYI: there is a **0-16 ATS** perfect tightener inside this theory, one in which Utah State stumbled in last year. Read all about it on the **playbook.com** website when you click on the **BLACK BOOK SYSTEMS** links inside the **BETTING TOOLS** section.

So when it comes to going full circle, remember that the task is much taller than the undertaking. Sir Elton John confirms it with this closing message:

“Some of us fall by the wayside
And some of us soar to the stars
And some of us sail
through our troubles
And some have to live with the scars.

Some say eat or be eaten
Some say live and let live
But all are agreed
as they join the stampede
You should never take more
than you give
In the circle of life.”

SORRY SEEMS TO BE THE HARDEST WORD

Ask yourself this one question: if NFL home underdogs are considered inferior opposition, then why do they tend to bark louder than road favorites?

The answer, in its simplest form, is because we look upon their road-favored counterparts as being the better team. And in most cases they are. But it doesn't mask the fact that NFL home dogs have had the upper hand in the pointspread wars, going 1388-1287-69 ATS on the blind since 1980.

One thing is for certain: NFL home dogs that were playoff teams the previous year have nothing to be sorry about. No siree. Not when these quality home pups have growled to the tune of 262-209-15 ATS dating back to 1989.

Better yet, bring our playoff home dog in with a winning record and let the yapping begin...

PLAY ON any NFL team with a winning record as a home dog if they were a playoff team the previous season.

If you had backed these teams, you wouldn't have apologized to anyone

as these quality home dogs have gone 62-39-4 ATS since 1989, including **7-0-1 ATS** last season alone.

Better yet, when facing a foe off a pointspread win of 7 or more points, these top-notch puppies improve to **32-12-1 ATS**.

It's the exact same role in which Indianapolis (+8.5 vs. New England) and Pittsburgh (+5 vs. Arizona) – the only two qualifying teams – excelled in last year, going **2-0 ATS**.

Best of all, you can zero in on a **15-0 ATS** subset to the angle. To find the perfect subset within the study, simply visit the **BETTING TOOLS** section contained under the BLACK BOOK link at Playbook.com.

So if you're thinking of betting a road favorite against a playoff team at any point of the season, you're on your own. For as Rock and Roll Hall of Famer Elton John would say:

Why can't we talk it over?
Oh it seems to me
