CANDLE IN THE WIND

reseason football polls are like tits on a bull. There's not much you can do with them other than to imagine or wonder what if.

Because after all, depending on what you conjure up, it really doesn't mean a thing... until the games begin.

For teams like Alabama, the defending national champion and this year's expected No. 1 college football team in the preseason polls, the prestigious early ranking is simply a declaration that expectations are exceedingly high and that the bulls-eye has been targeted and is now firmly in place.

It should be known that preseason No. 1 teams are, for the most part, highly successful. These teams have gone 387-67-1 SU in all games since 1980. And they're at their best against the spread in games when playing off a pointspread loss, going 101-87-3 ATS over the same span, including a stellar 97-79-3 ATS when favored.

They are at their very best, however, in games after having had the rug pulled out from under them as a favorite the previous game...

PLAY ON any AP Preseason

No. 1 college team as a favorite

off a SU favorite loss in their

previous game.

Had you had the foresight to back teams in this situation, you would own a sparkling 25-15 ATS mark in these games since 1980. FYI: these mad-as-hell favorites are also 36-4 SU in these same games.

Put them up against quality opposition (greater than .600) and they shoot up to **17-4 ATS** in this role. Better yet, have them enter this same game with

a win percentage of .900 or less on the season and they ratchet up to 15-1 ATS.

And for what it's worth, a super subset resides inside this angle that has never lost – going **15-0 ATS**. Best of all, you can view it on the **BETTING TOOLS** section contained under the BLACK BOOK link at **Playbook.com**.

Last year witnessed one qualifying play when Ohio State traveled to the Big House in Michigan, off a 17-14 loss as 16.5-point favorites to Michigan State. The Buckeyes carried the torch when they went on to whip the Wolverines, 42-13, as manageable 1-point road chalk.

So should the Tide find itself favored this season after having been tripped up as a favorite in its previous game, you know what to do. Because, after all, it was the legendary Elton John who reminded us:

hanging roles. It's never been easy. And while it's become commonplace in the world in which we live today – from 50 Shades of Grey to Caitlyn Jenner – it's always an uncomfortable, uphill journey.

The same holds true in the world of college football whenever teams are asked to assume a new role from one game to the next. Particularly so when they are suddenly favored after having just pulled an upset as an underdog.

In fact, college football conference road favorites off a SU conference home underdog win own a meager 77-104-4 ATS losing mark since 1980.

Better yet, our well-oiled machine tells us the best role in which to fade these situation role changers is to...

PLAY AGAINST any college football conference road favorite off a SU home underdog win versus an opponent off a SU underdog win.

That's because these uncomfortable road favorites are a **2-21 ATS** losing proposition in this hard-to-handle role change since 1990.

Last year witnessed two such plays when Utah State journeyed out as

4-point road chalk at San Diego State after upsetting Boise State, 52-26, as 7.5-point home pups the previous week. The Aggies promptly fell on their face in a 48-14 loss against the Aztecs. San Diego State then went out as 3-point road faves the following week at Colorado State, yet somehow managed to win and cover against the Rams in a rare win.

FYI: there is a **0-16 ATS** perfect tightener inside this theory, one in which Utah State stumbled in last year. Read all about it on the **playbook. com** website when you click on the BLACK BOOK SYSTEMS links inside the **BETTING TOOLS** section.

So when it comes to going full circle, remember that the task is much taller than the undertaking. Sir Elton John confirms it with this closing message:
